

EGOLF Quality Policy 2017

General

All members shall apply a systematic and disciplined approach to quality which can demonstrate they consistently meet their technical and organizational objectives and the declared expectations and needs of their clients.

All members shall develop continuously and commit to improve their quality and technical competence according to the latest EGOLF strategy for continuous quality improvement as may be agreed by EGOLF Assemblée Générale.

1. Testing activities, applicable to all members undertaking fire testing

1.1 All members shall be accredited to EN ISO/IEC 17025.

1.2 All members shall implement EGA 08 'Accreditation of fire laboratories – interpretation of EN ISO/IEC 17025 for fire laboratories'.

1.3 All members shall have at least one employee trained on an EGOLF Harmonisation Course for every test method which they perform for which there is a course available.

1.4 All members are expected to participate in all relevant round robins organized by EGOLF when these are corresponding to the test methods performed by the member laboratory.

2. Inspection activities, applicable to all members undertaking inspection, unless these activities are covered by their scope of accreditation to EN ISO/IEC 17065

Unless inspection activities are covered by their scope of accreditation to EN ISO/IEC 17065, all members shall be accredited to EN ISO/IEC 17020.

3. Certification activities, applicable to all members undertaking certification

All members shall be accredited to EN ISO/IEC 17065.
